Short Biographical Sketch

Giancarlo Di Vella is full professor in legal medicine in the University of Turin (School of Medicine and Department of Jurisprudence) and serves as a forensic pathologist in the University Hospital “Città della Salute e della Scienza di Torino”; he is vice-president of the Bioethical Committee of the University of Turin.

After receiving his BD cum laude in Medicine in the University of Bari, he graduated as Ph.D. in “Analytical Morphometry and Biomedical and Anthropometrical Application” in University La Sapienza in Rome and he completed the forensic fellowship in the University of Bari where he worked after as associate professor in legal medicine until 2013 when he changed position as full professor in legal medicine in the University of Turin. Past president of the International Association of Craniofacial identification, he is international fellow of the College of American Pathologists, fellow of the AAFS (path/bio section) and fellow of the NAME (past member of BoD); actually, he is president of the Italian Group of the Forensic Pathology (GIPF) and fellow of the Italian Society of Legal Medicine.

He has presented research at numerous national and international meetings and published more than 200 peer-reviewed papers, chapters and texts. He serves on the editorial boards of the *Minerva Forensic Medicine* (pISSN 2784-8922 - eISSN 2784-8639) and of the *Journal of Forensic Science and Medicine* - ISSN: 2349-5014; eISSN: 2455-0094 - WK).
