Lorraine du Toit-Prinsloo is a forensic pathologist at Forensic Medicine, New South Wales Health Pathology, Forensic and Analytical Science Service, Australia.

She obtained her MBChB degree from the University of Pretoria, South Africa where after she commenced specialisation in forensic pathology. She completed her 4 year training at the University of Pretoria and obtained the MMed(Path)(Forens) degree and the Fellowship of the College of Forensic Pathologist of South Africa (FCForPath(SA)). She was appointed as a senior lecturer in forensic medicine at the University of Pretoria and later promoted to adjunct professor. She supervised trainees in pathology and forensic science.

Dr. du Toit-Prinsloo immigrated to Australia and completed the Fellowship of the Royal College of Pathologists of Australasia. She has presented research at national and international meetings and published more than 50 peer-reviewed manuscripts, and 3 book chapters.
