

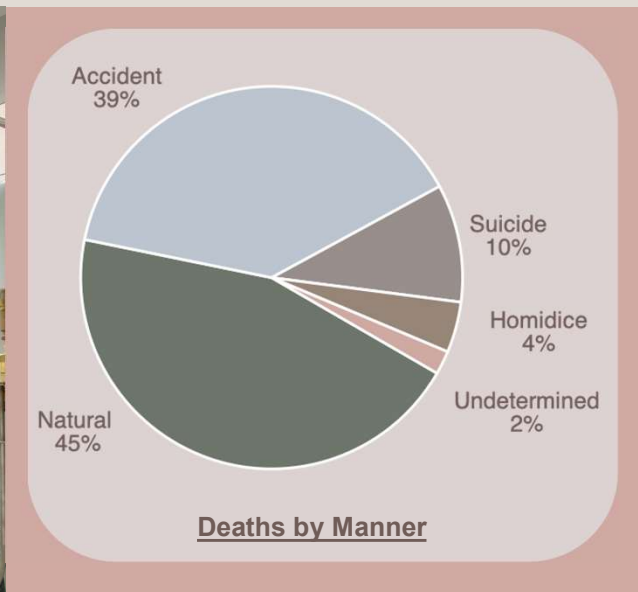

The Cobb County Medical Examiner's Office has a new state of the art facility, which opened in September 2020; utilizing the most current forensic equipment. We received NAME accreditation in 2022. Our staff includes 3 full-time medical examiners, 4 part-time medical examiners, 4 technicians, 2 admin staff, 1 Deputy Director, 9 full-time investigators, and 1 part-time investigator. The average number of accepted cases per year is ~950, including case reviews and external examinations.



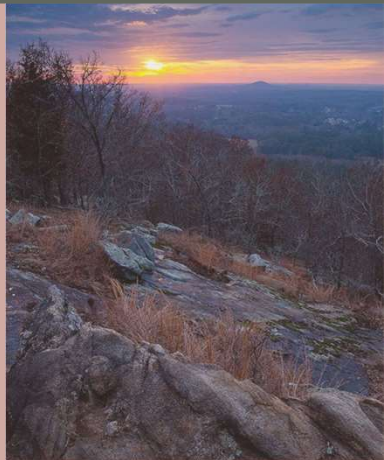
