**FACULTY POSITION IN FORENSIC AND AUTOPSY PATHOLOGY**

The Department of Pathology at The University of Iowa Roy J. and Lucille A. Carver College of Medicine seeks candidates for an Assistant, Associate or Professor position on either the tenure track or non-tenure clinical track to take part in an active forensic and autopsy pathology service with or without surgical pathology or other areas of pathology. Required qualifications include:

- MD or equivalent
- Forensic pathology fellowship training with board certification (or “board eligible”)
- Graduation from an accredited Anatomic Pathology or Anatomic Pathology/Clinical Pathology residency program
- Board certified or board eligible in Anatomic Pathology or Anatomic Pathology/Clinical Pathology with the credentials required to obtain a medical license in the State of Iowa

In addition to the required qualifications, the following qualifications are highly desirable:

- Demonstrated ability to excel at teaching and scholarship
- Demonstrated interest in family consent autopsies
- Additional training/interest in another subspecialty area of pathology

This position will sustain forensic pathologist availability in SE Iowa and the new faculty member will also have an appointment as a Medical Examiner for Johnson County, IA.

Applications should include a CV, a letter of interest containing a statement of career goals, and the names and addresses of three individuals who could provide letters of reference.
