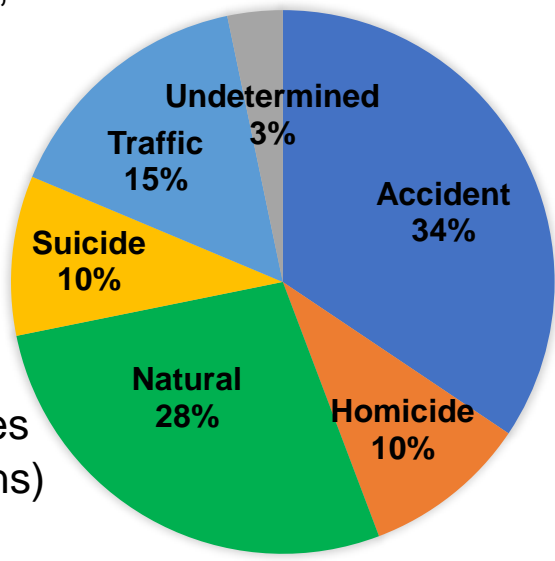

 - Doctors average ~250 autopsies/year
 - Chief fully integrated in cutting schedule and takes organ/tissue donation call
- 128 slice CT scanner at Perris office, and full body LODOX imaging at both facilities
- In 2022 the office performed 1600 forensic autopsies
- Twelve coroner technicians (assist with eviscerations)
- Two transcriptionists
- Histology and toxicology, genetic services sent to external laboratory with quick turn-around time
- Eye/Neuropathology, forensic anthropology, and forensic odontology consultants available
