The successful applicant will join two (2) board certified forensic pathologists who provide medical examiner and services for the eight counties in upper east Tennessee.

The office performs approximately 750 autopsies/examinations per year and additionally employs a professional, well-trained full staff of death investigators, autopsy technicians and administrative support staff.

Minimum requirements include: M.D. or D.O. degree, certification by the American Board of Pathology in Anatomic Pathology and Forensic Pathology, and eligibility for medical licensure in Tennessee.
