

Assistant Medical Examiner Opening

The Hennepin County Medical Examiner's Office, located in scenic suburban Minneapolis, seeks a full-time Assistance Medical Examiner.

This position serves Hennepin, Dakota and Scott Counties, and referral counties in the region. The salary range is \$166,347.42 – \$263,894.70 annually, dependent on qualifications, combined with a desirable benefits package.

The ideal candidate will be a licensed physician or eligible for license to practice medicine in the state of Minnesota (M.D. or D.O.) and qualified as a pathologist certified or eligible for certification in forensic pathology by the American Board of Pathology.

The office is accredited by the National Association of Medical Examiners and sponsors an ACGME-accredited fellowship in forensic pathology. The office also employs a death investigation team that is required to be certified by the American Board of Medicolegal Death Investigators.

Join a team of eight forensic pathologists and one forensic anthropologist who have nationwide influence and play an active leadership role in improving medicolegal death investigation and forensic through committee and board memberships, including:
