

Medical Examiner position - Greenville, South Carolina

Pathology Associates of Greenville, SC is seeking a qualified candidate for the position of Medical Examiner of Greenville County, SC. This candidate will join 20+ member group of pathologists, including four full-time forensic pathologists (when fully staffed) that cover Greenville and neighboring counties. Three Greenville-based forensic pathologists cover three counties from our primary facility, and one full-time forensic pathologist covers nearby Spartanburg County at a separate hospital facility. This position is for a Greenville-based pathologist.

Forensic pathology fellows are encouraged to apply. The ideal qualified candidate will AP certified and FP board certified or eligible at the start date. A current and unrestricted license to practice medicine in South Carolina will be required by the start date.

Responsibilities of the medical examiner will be the performance of approximately 250 total cases, approximately 20% of which are external examinations or, occasionally, head only autopsies. The selected candidate will cover forensic cases for the Greenville facility on weekdays and all autopsies for the group (including Spartanburg County) on one out of every four Saturdays. Autopsies are not routinely performed on Sundays. Four weeks of paid vacation and attendance at two professional meetings per year will be covered by the group's other three forensic pathologists.

The Greenville-based pathologists have Assistant Clinical Professor appointments at the University of South Carolina School of Medicine Greenville, where we teach portions of the M2 pathology curriculum. We have close ties with the medical school with availability of PhD forensic anthropology on campus.

All toxicology is performed by National Medical Services laboratory with rapid turnaround results. Radiology and infectious disease testing are performed at the on campus hospital. Consultation with other pathology specialists in the group is easily accessible, and remote consultation with a neuropathologist is available. Scene investigation is performed by the local coroner and his staff.

The upstate of South Carolina is wonderful, family friendly place to live with excellent outdoor activities including nearby lakes and mountains - and the coast only three hours away. Greenville is a pleasant, small but growing city, and the cost of living is well below most metropolitan areas.

Compensation is competitive with a generous benefits package that includes professional account, liability, medical and dental insurance coverage, and a generous profit sharing retirement plan.
