

The Whatcom County Medical Examiner has worked in the past as an independent agency operating under a professional services contract. In November 2023, County Council approved the budget authority and position control necessary to bring the Medical Examiner and staff into Whatcom County employment. This transition offers the opportunity for more collaboration of resources, including grant opportunities, and better retention and stability of staff in professions where recruitment is in high demand. The County morgue is located in downtown Bellingham and is currently under renovation, through September 2024, to modernize facilities, improve operational efficiency, and ensure the highest standards of forensic pathology and public health services. The County anticipates working with the Medical Examiner's Office to assess resources and operations, potentially constructing a new modern morgue facility.
