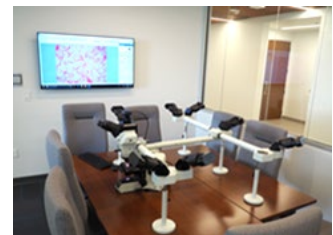

ABOUT THE OFFICE

- State-of-the-art 52,000 square-foot facility completed in 2018 with computed tomography
- Accredited by the National Association of Medical Examiners (NAME) since 2009
- In-house tox laboratory accredited by the ANSI National Accreditation Board (ISO/IEC 17025), histology laboratory, and Neuropathologist
- Robust staffing:

The Travis County Medical Examiner's office is located in the capital city of Austin, Texas. The population of Travis County is approximately 1.3 million, and the office also provides services to 49 counties outside of Travis County. Our office performed 2159 autopsies and 547 external examinations in 2024.

OPPORTUNITY HIGHLIGHTS
