West Tennessee Regional Forensic Center (WTRFC) Consultant Requirements to Develop a Request for Proposal (RFP) for successful Daily Operations

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Contract Title: Consultant to Develop RFP for Operating WTRFC

TERM: The initial contract term will begin immediately upon execution of the contract through June 30, _2025_. The Consultant must be prepared to begin immediately upon receipt of a fully executed contract and written Notice to Proceed from the County.

REQUIREMENTS: Provider must be a Medical Doctor with Forensic Pathology experience with all appropriate Licenses and Certifications required in the State of Tennessee to perform the Pathology/Forensics Services required. Provide a copy of your Shelby County Business License (if the business is located in Shelby County, TN).

- 1. Must have 3 to 5 years' experience in Forensic pathology and understanding of Forensic Technology and processes of a Regional Forensic Center.
- 2. Evaluate the management staff and ensure staff can provide all services as required by the Post-Mortem Examination Act, Tennessee Code Annotated ss 34-7-101, et sequitur (the "Management Services") necessary to operate the West Tennessee Regional Forensic Center.
- 3. Ability to assess Forensic Center operations and make recommendations on the following services: Professional staffing, Support Staffing and needed credentials according to the National Association of Medical Examiners (NAME) standards.
- 4. Analyze current Forensic Center operations and benchmark against best practices and make recommendations for continuous/quality improvement according to NAME standards.

Mission

- 5. Analyze current Forensic Center operations and provide a cost proposal and staffing plan to achieve maximum productivity.
- 6. General experience in developing and writing a RFP for Forensic Medical Management providers to provide best in class service.
- 7. RFP developer must have M.D. or Ph.D. in Pathology and/or Forensic Science and worked at least 5 years in a Forensic Center so as to consult and advise Shelby County Government on contractual professional Forensic services.
- 8. Ability to provide metrics and or benchmarks for providers and for SCHD to monitor and measure service, e.g. autopsies, investigations
- 9. Provide a list of 3 to 5 clients (name and phone number) for the RFP that can provide Forensic Management Services for a large metropolitan area.
- 10. Recommendation on improving current programs in RFP development for a Forensic Center located in a large Metropolitan Area.
- 11. RFP recommendation must include monitoring the WTRFC services with established NAME standards and acquiring and maintaining NAME Accreditation.

Provide high-quality RFP for potential candidates to compete to operate the WTRFC and comply
