About the Washoe County Regional Medical Examiner's Office

The Washoe County Regional Medical Examiner's Office (WCRMEO), serves all of Northern Nevada (14 counties) and part of Northern California (5 counties). The staff relocated to a brand-new, state-of-the-art, medical examiner facility in January 2017, and continue to enjoy this highly functional and beautiful building. The office operates with a staff of 29. Full-time Medicolegal Death Investigators are cross-trained in investigations and autopsy, and are

ABMDI certified. Autopsies/examinations are performed by 3 Assistant Medical Examiners, the Chief Medical Examiner, and additional locum tenens forensic pathologists. During 2021, 6,331 deaths were reported to the WCRMEO with just over 1,400 examinations performed. The staff enjoys high morale in the workplace and functions with mutual respect and a good sense of humor.

Minimum Qualifications

Graduation from an accredited school of medicine and possession of (or eligibility to obtain prior to start date) a current license to practice medicine in the state of Nevada.

Experience in forensic pathology, to include completion of an accredited fellowship in forensic pathology.

Certification by the American Board of Pathology in forensic pathology, or board-eligible in forensic pathology if recent fellowship graduate.

Conditions of Employment

Possess a current license to practice medicine in the State of Nevada. Reference and background checks will be conducted on selected applicants. Successful candidates should have the ability to work at least 4 consecutive days per visit to Reno, if non-local. Locum tenens pathologists must provide evidence of Nevada malpractice insurance coverage.

HOW TO APPLY After reviewing and verifying that you have met the Minimum Qualifications for the position, you are requested to submit a Curriculum Vitae to Dr. Laura Knight, Chief Medical Examiner, at ldknight@washoecounty.gov. Applicants who have the most potential for success in the position will be contacted for an interview.

Locum Tenens Position Information And Compensation

- \$1,000 per autopsy performed, \$600 per limited autopsy (head-only cases), and \$400 per external examination
- A \$1,000 "bonus" for prompt completion of paperwork may be billed after completion of each 15 examination reports returned to the WCRMEO within 60 days of the examination.
- Economy/coach airfare (excludes early bird/pre-check in fees and upgraded class/seating)
- Hotel and Internet (\$102.00 maximum reimbursement per night, \$126 maximum per night in the months of July and August)
- Ground transportation (compact automobile rental, taxi, shuttle, airport parking, etc.)
- Fuel
- Food/Beverage (Federal per diem rate for Reno, NV)

Locum Tenens pathologists will cover only routine, non-criminal cases each day. Staff pathologists typically cover any homicides, traffic fatalities with charges pending, or suspicious or high-profile deaths.
