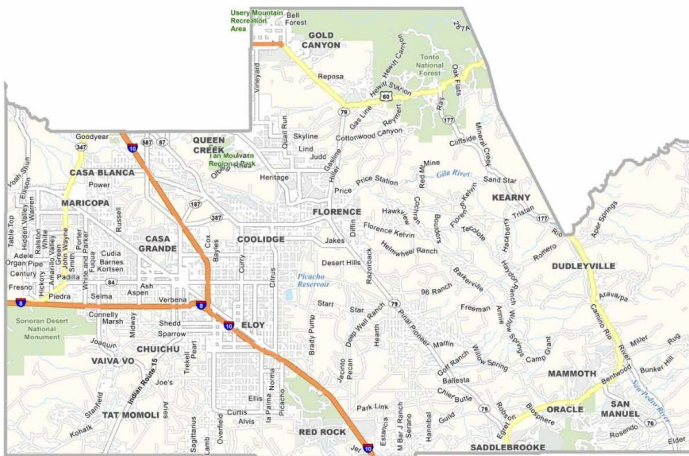

Forensic Pathology at PCMEO
