WHAT IS PMCT / NON-INVASIVE AUTOPSY?

Postmortem computed tomography (CT) is a medical imaging technique used to examine the body of a deceased individual after death. It is a non-invasive imaging procedure that allows forensic pathologists/forensic radiologists to view a body's anatomy and diagnose pathology without dissection.

Postmortem CT has numerous applications, including diagnosis of traumatic injuries and natural disease.
